

Sibford School's Attitude to Learning (AtL) Level Descriptors

This is a description of your son/daughter's approach to their studies, the bulleted list gives an indication of the types of attitude and behaviour they display. It is a **best-fit** model and your son/daughter may not display **all** of the characteristics in the category. The emboldened descriptor is a prerequisite for achieving that level.

6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Takes full responsibility for his/her learning and maximises the use of the available learning opportunities • Displays an exceptional level of effort and commitment • Often shows an ability to work independently • Always punctual with appropriate equipment/kit/books
5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demonstrates a high level of enthusiasm in their work • Shows a high level of commitment • Is developing the skills required to maximise the available learning opportunities • Always punctual with appropriate equipment/kit/books
4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demonstrates enthusiasm and commitment • Demonstrates some initiative, seeking assistance when required • Is beginning to make effective use of available learning opportunities • Punctual, always with appropriate equipment/kit/books
3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shows variable commitment. • Is capable of distinguishing what is needed to enhance his/her learning but may lack the initiative or motivation to make the most of the available learning opportunities • Is usually punctual with appropriate equipment/kit/books
2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May demonstrate little motivation to learn • May show only minimal commitment to class work • Behaviour and/or attentiveness may be inconsistent • Is usually punctual with appropriate equipment/kit/books
1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Behaviour, inattention and/or a negative attitude adversely affect his/her own learning and that of others • Effort is unacceptable • Minimal commitment in the subject • Rarely punctual, often without appropriate equipment/kit/books
