Banbury School and Penguin have come together to present year 7 pupils with a fantastic opportunity to meet the author and illustrator Curtis Jobling.

On Thursday 10th November 2011 Curtis Jobling will be talking at Banbury School about his Wereworld series set in the imagined and highly inventive world of lycanthropes. He will talk about his love of film/books, explaining animation, different mediums, being the designer of Bob the Builder and working on Wallace & Gromit. He will show the audience how he creates his characters and getting them to challenge him to draw things from their wildest imaginations. There will be role-playing and a 'werewolves in cinema' pop quiz, before a gripping chapter reading from the new book, **Rage of Lions**, the second in the series. The event concludes with a lively question and answer session, plus a book signing.



The first book in the Wereworld series is **Rise of the Wolf** :



'You're the last of the werewolves son. Don't fight it...Conquer it.' When the air is clear, sixteen year-old Drew Ferran can pick up the scent of a predator. When the moon breaks through the clouds, a terrifying fever grips him. And when a vicious beast invades his home, his flesh tears, his fingers become claws, and Drew transforms ...Forced to flee the family he loves, Drew seeks refuge in the most godforsaken parts of Lyssia. But when he is captured by Lord Bergan's men, Drew must prove he is not the enemy. Can Drew battle the werereatures determined to destroy him - and master the animal within?
