Dear Gillett House member

I write to you with regards to a planned charity fundraiser. We have booked Ogwen Cottage www.ogwencottage.co.uk at Bethesda, Snowdonia for the night of 23rd March 2012. We will travel by coach departing in the afternoon and on Saturday we will ascend Snowdonia, the highest mountain in Wales. This will take approximately 3-4 hours; the descent takes half an hour less on average. The expedition will be led by qualified mountain rangers, and accompanied by Sibford School staff. We aim to return to school by early evening on the Saturday. On the Saturday, if the guides advise us that the weather would make walking up Mount Snowdon hazardous, we will undertake an alternative walk recommended by the guide.

Each participant will need to raise the first £90 to cover the cost of travel, accommodation, the Guide, and food (we will provide a packed tea on the Friday and there will be an opportunity to buy snacks at the motorway services). In addition we would like to collectively raise over £1,000 for a cancer charity nominated by one of our House members who has a personal connection with it. This trip open to all years and pupils will be arranged into groups of ten to walk up Mount Snowdon.
