Prep for Drama, Art and Music.

The drama department will set prep, either written or research based, that relates to the practical work pupils participate in during class. This will equal approximately 120 minutes work per month.

Pupils are expected to undertake regular unsupervised Art work (prep.) usually related to their current creative discipline. This will amount to approximately 120 minutes per month.

Music prep is set each fortnight so students on average will be set 3 preps per half-term, involving 30 minutes work each.

Subjects in GCSE option blocks may set a second prep when appropriate

LS set prep as appropriate

ESOL set prep after every lesson

Pupils in years 7-9 will be set either History, Geography or RS each week.
